
European National oral exam end of residency

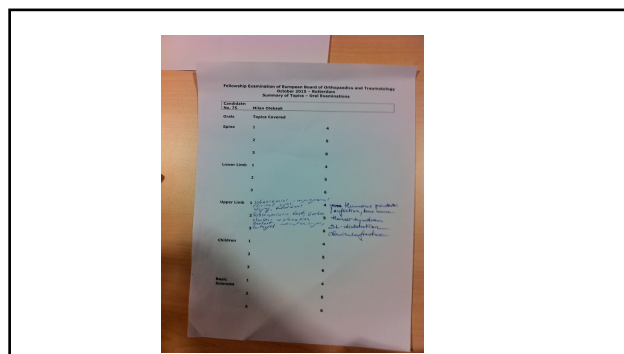

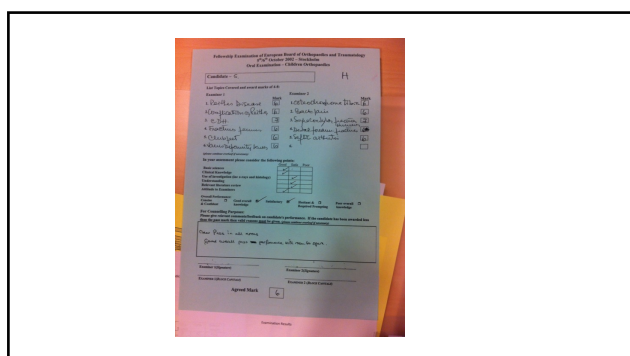
Final Examination

- Clear rules...and staff...

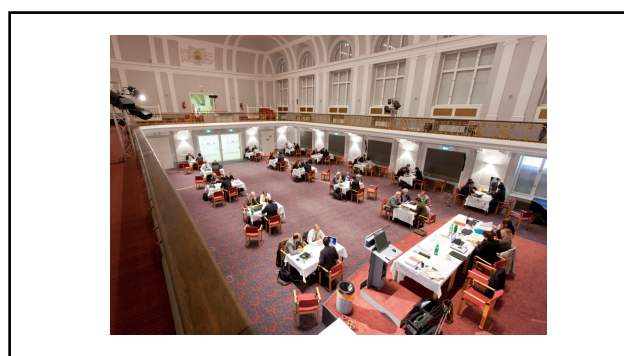
